Our head offices are at the **Big Travel Rhodes Branch**, therefore, regardless to where your Wedding will take place, all documents should be forwarded to Leoforos Rhodes -Lindos 3 klm 85100. The Rhodes wedding department will translate all your documents and get all documents apostilled and send them to Kos wedding department before your arrival.

If you are having your documents translated with another company, you need to have them with you during your first meeting with your Wedding Coordinator.

How can I book my Wedding with you?

You can book your Wedding directly with us.

How many Weddings do you do per day?

One Wedding per day takes place in all our venues.

What days are available for a Wedding?

It depends on the venue. Ask your wedding coordinator for more information on the available dates.

Once in Kos

• Do we meet someone in order to discuss the Wedding Arrangements? You will be notified upon your arrival about the date and time of your meeting with your Wedding Coordinator at the offices of Big Travel Kos Branch.

During your meeting you will go through all the details regarding your big day and you can make changes or last minute arrangements.

Town Hall

• Why do we need to go to the Town Hall?

The Town Hall is where you will get legally married.

• What needs to be done as preparation?

You need to make sure you have gathered all the required documents prior to your arrival.

If you are translating your legal documents with us you need to send them over to us at least one and a half months prior to your arrival.

If you are having your documents translated with another company, you need to have them with you during your first meeting with your Wedding Coordinator.

What happens at the Town Hall?

Your Wedding Coordinator will advise you the exact date and time of the meeting at the Town Hall for the signing of your legal paperwork.

- The signing usually takes place 1 2 days prior to your Ceremony.
- You need to have 2 witnesses above the age of 18.
- The Marriage Certificate will be ready to collect approximately 3 days after the signing.
- The Groom will be requested to sign in order to collect it from the Town Hall.

You will be required to make your own way to the Town Hall at your own expense.

Your witnesses will need to be with you and you will sign paperwork in a very short procedure.

Your Wedding Coordinator will be with you.
